An intelligent use of spot light emphasizing the artwork on the wall is a clear show stealer. The side table can be reached without leaving the comfort of your sheet (Ahh...what bliss!!!) and make your bed an awesome crashing pad.

The first word that crosses my mind is lively!!! In a young 8 year old boy's room, a vivid use of blue hues bring a nice whiff of freshness. The car wall paper behind the TV unit, a panelling above the bed back rest gives this contrast glamour of blue and white!
